<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All fees listed are the maximum amount charged per student for each class or school-sponsored activity. Actual amount charged may be less. 2. Any payment for student participation in a class, program, or activity is a fee and is subject to the fee waiver requirement. For information on fee waivers and other details, contact the office. 3. All students are responsible to pay for any loss, breakage, or damage they cause to school property. Loss, breakage, or damage is not subject to the waiver requirement. These costs are defined as a "fine". Official transcript may be withheld if breakage or damage costs are not paid in accordance with the Utah Code Ann. §53G-8-212. 4. Donations are permissible, but all such requests are voluntary. A student may not be excluded from an activity or program because they did not donate. 5. All requests for overnight/out of state travel must be approved and comply with all requirements outlined in the school's fieldwork policy. 6. The max aggregate amount for fees related to Elementary and Middle School courses, activities and other miscellaneous fees per student is \$300.00 (Per student, per year) 7. Payment plans are available for families if needed, please check with office. 8. As much as possible, we offer courses with and without fees to accommodate all students. 9. All fees are due no later than 30 days after the start of the quarter. 	
<p>Definitions:</p> <p>Extracurricular: means an activity, course, or program, outside of school hours, that is sponsored, recognized, or sanctioned by the</p> <p>School Fee: A charge, expense deposit, rental or payment, regardless of how an LEA terms, describes, requests, or requires the charge, expense, deposit, rental, or payment, directly or indirectly, in the form of money, goods, or services; and that is a condition to a student's full participation in or admission to an activity, course, or program that an LEA provides, sponsors, or supports.</p> <p>Fee Course: A course that is not a non-fee course.</p> <p>Instructional Equipment: An activity course, or program-related tool that a student is required to use as part of an activity, course, or program and becomes the property of the student upon exiting the course or program. It does not include school equipment.</p> <p>Instructional Supply: A non-reusable or consumable material or supply that is necessary to use, expend, or delete as a component or element of an activity, course or program. It does not include a personal student supply.</p> <p>Non-Fee Course: A course that is part of the core curriculum required for high school graduation.</p> <p>Non-waivable charges: Non-waivable charges include: charge for school breakfast or lunch, a fine for improper use of school property including a library fine for lost or damaged materials, or personal consumable items, such as: yearbook, Leadership t-shirt.</p>
