

2026 Parent Spring Notification Letter School Climate Survey

The School Climate Survey is an anonymous survey used to assess stakeholder perception of a school environment (see [Utah Code Section 53G-8-802](#) and [Board Rule R277-623](#)) and is administered to students and adults.

Students can participate in the survey that aligns with their current grade level. Student survey versions include: kindergarten - 2nd, 3rd-5th, and 6th-12th. Adults can participate in the survey that aligns with the role of the adult. Adults survey versions include: administrator, faculty and staff, school resource officer, and parents.

A copy of each survey is available for viewing on the [School Safety Center data page](#). The data collected will be reviewed by Local Education Agencies (LEAs) in order to:

- 1) revise policies, practices, and training to reduce harassment and discrimination in each school within the LEA;
- 2) inform plans to promote harassment-free and discrimination-free learning;
- 3) provide insights that can be shared at outreach events to inform students and parents of plans adopted from the review.

[Utah Code Section 53E-9-203](#) requires parent permission during student registration of the same school year for your child to participate in the survey. You are receiving this notification because you have provided your permission for your child to take the School Climate Survey. Your child may stop the survey at any time or skip questions if they choose. They will not be penalized for not participating. If you have changed your mind, please return this form with your signature below.
