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Agenda & Discussion Summary:

1. Council Membership Updates

- **Lichelle Watne** to be removed from the council member list. **Erin Sullivan** was added to replace Lichelle
 - **April's** role was updated to "Staff Member."
 - **Erin** is temporarily filling in for **Paul**.
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2. Approval of 2025–2026 Meeting Calendar

- The proposed meeting calendar for the 2025–2026 academic year was **reviewed and approved** by the council.

3. Training & General Information

- Council reviewed the **School Land Trust Member Training Slides** provided by the **USBE**.
- Hard copies of the training materials were distributed for future reference.

4. Review of Current TSSP (Teacher and Student Success Plan)

- **Graduation Goal (March Goal):**
Original: Maintain graduation rate at **95%**.
Amendment proposed: Update 2024 data point from **88%** to the current 2025 rate of **92.2%**.
- Reviewed how the **School Improvement Plan** aligns with the TSSP goals and overall school priorities.

5. TSSP Amendment Proposal Discussion

- Erin led a discussion on the need to amend the current TSSP to better reflect **current student needs**.
- The original plan approved in Spring 2025 no longer fully aligns with those needs.

Key Discussion Points:

- **Erin:** Proposed keeping \$5,000 allocated for **ELL Professional Development**.
- **Larry:** Suggested fair division of the \$5,000 across departments.
- **Cindy:** Asked about specific classroom needs and ELL student struggles.
- **Jennifer:** Questioned whether \$50,000 is sufficient for a full-time academic interventionist.

- **Erin:** Confirmed that the \$50,000 is appropriate and includes salary and benefits. Also confirmed that the title would not impact pay.
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Approved Amendment Proposal

Funding Allocation:

- **\$50,000 – Full-time Academic Interventionist**
 - Includes salary and benefits
 - Responsibilities include:
 - Monitoring student progress weekly (every Monday)
 - Teachers posting grades weekly
 - Providing academic interventions for students who are failing
- **\$5,000 – Technology, Supplies, and Professional Development**
Allocated across:
 - Math
 - Language Arts
 - Science
 - Social Studies
 - ELL Training
