

# Family Educational Rights and Privacy Policy

## Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to protect the privacy of Wallace Stegner Academy (the "School") students and their families in accordance with applicable law.

## Policy

The School shall protect the privacy of its students and their families and shall support parental involvement in the education of their children by complying with state and federal law concerning family educational rights and privacy, including but not limited to the federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act ("FERPA") and Utah Code § 53E-9-201 *et seq.*

The School's Chief Executive Officer(s) shall establish administrative procedures that provide standards under Utah law for the protection of student and family privacy within the School, including in the curriculum, in School activities, in the administration of psychological or psychiatric examinations, tests, or treatments to students, and in any survey, analysis, or evaluation of students that seek protected information. The procedures shall also address the management of student education records under FERPA, including rules regarding parental access to and the School's disclosure of such education records.
