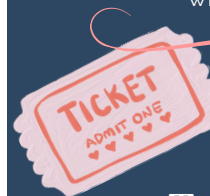

## MATH CORNER



Hello Families!

Happy March—it's time to celebrate Pi DAY! On 3.14 or March 14, there is an awesome opportunity to delve into some fun math activities. Here are some ideas for your family!

- 1. Bake a Pi(e)**--You might not even realize it, but you're teaching your kiddos some important math fundamentals while following a recipe. Assuming your pie is round, you can also talk about fractions, circumference, and of course pi ... as you eat your pie.
- 2. Hold a pi scavenger hunt**--Have kids find items representing 3.14159... in order. So kids could gather three spoons, one plate, four crayons, one puzzle piece, five paper clips and nine pennies. Who can go the furthest down the infinite decimal line in a certain amount of time -- 3 minutes and 14 seconds perhaps?
- 3. Create circle art**--Cut large circles out of paper or simply use paper plates. Cut the circles in half or quarters (depending on how many people are participating). Have each person decorate their piece of the circle, then put them back together to make one-of-a-kind art.

## Attendance Matters!

Did you know?

- Too many absences in elementary school can cause children to struggle socially and academically.
- Being late to school may lead to poor attendance.
- Missing 10% of school (2 days each month) can make it harder to learn to read and do basic math.
- Students should miss no more than 9 days of school each year to stay engaged and on track to graduation.
- By 6th grade, chronic absence (missing 10%, or 2 days each month) is one of three signs that a student may drop out of high school.
- By 9th grade, attendance is a better predictor of graduation rates than 8th grade test scores.
