

Hawthorn Academy's Dress Code

Tops: must have a collar and sleeves, including blouses, polos, turtlenecks, and button-downs. No logos, no exposed midribs, and no holes.

Colors: white, true red, navy, or light blue.

Sweaters: may be worn in the approved colors, over a collared shirt.

Quarter-Zip & Crew Necks: may be worn in neutral colors (grey, black, white, beige) or uniform colors.

Jackets & Hoodies: must be Hawthorn-issued to be worn indoors (no hoods on). Outdoor jackets are not dress-coded.



Bottoms: Pants, shorts, skirts, and jumpers.

Colors: navy, khaki, or black.

No tight pants, denim, or holes. Pants must be worn above the hip. Shorts and skirts must come to the top of the kneecap, even when leggings are worn. Leggings must be in approved colors. Jumpers must be worn with a dress code top.

Dresses: navy or khaki.



Socks and Tights: socks or tights must be worn and visible at all times. Small logos are permitted. Tights must be opaque; no nylons. No no-show socks.

Colors: red, navy, white, or black.

Shoes: can be any color but must be closed-toe and closed-heeled. No lights, wheels, or characters. Snow boots must be changed at school.



Wear What You Want Wednesday: Hawthorn's PTO organizes a Wear What You Want Wednesday once a month. Students donate \$1 to wear clothing of their choice while still being dress code appropriate: no holes, exposed midribs, or sagging pants.

Spirit Day: Fridays for Elementary and Thursdays for Middle School. Students may wear house apparel.

Field Trip Dress Code: White dress code top and navy blue or black dress code bottoms. No extreme hairstyles or unnatural hair colors.
